## Official Call for Elections Thursday, December 9, 2021 Tangier Shriners, Oasis of Omaha, Desert of Nebraska

The annual elections of Tangier Shriners will be held on Thursday, December 9, 2021 at 2823 S. 84<sup>th</sup> Street, Omaha Nebraska at 7:30 p.m. No later than 9:00 p.m. the annual election will start. Tangier Temple will elect seven Divan members, a Trustee for a four year term, Representatives to the Imperial Council and Central States Shrine Association, and any openings which may occur in the interim.

### Members must have their 2021 Dues Card for admission to this meeting

#### FROM IMPERIAL BY-LAWS (IOWA CORPORATION)

#### Article 25

- 325.4 When Elected. Each Temple must elect its Officers and Representatives at its annual meeting in January unless its bylaws allow the election to occur at the temple's stated meeting in December.
- 325.5 Ballot. Election of officers shall be by separate written ballot and by a majority vote of those present and voting. A blanket ballot is prohibited.
- 325.6 Time of Election. Nominations must commence no later than 9:00 p.m. and when that hour arrives all other business must cease and none may be transacted until the election is concluded.
- 325.7 Other Officers. The Temple may elect such other officers as its Bylaws provide.
- 325.8 Nominations. Candidates for office and Representatives must be placed in nomination from the floor.
- 325.10 Representatives.
- (a) Where a Temple elects more than one Representative, all candidates must be balloted for on one written ballot.
  - (b) Each member voting must vote only for the total number of Representatives to be elected, otherwise his ballot cannot be counted as a vote.
  - (c) A majority of those present and voting is necessary to elect each Representative.
  - (d) Only those candidates who receive a majority vote shall be declared elected.
  - (e) Successive written ballots must then be taken in the same manner on other candidates until all Representatives are elected.
  - (f) If more candidates receive a majority vote than the number of Representatives to be elected, then those receiving the greatest number of votes shall be declared elected.
  - (g) Blank ballots or ballots containing any markings other than the name of a candidate nominated from the floor are not votes and are not to be considered for any purpose.
- 325.11 Election Regulations.
- (a) A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.
  - (b) The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited.
  - (c) For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.
  - (d) At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.

# Tangier Tales



Greetings,

*It has been said that the shared history of a group is the tie that binds. History is certainly an important variable in the equation, to be sure. However, it can only serve as a guide and touchstone if it is a "known history."*

*There is very little involving the Shriners organization; as well as the overarching Masonic Institution, that isn't tied to history, tradition, and customs. As we seek to enhance and grow our fraternity, we must become reacquainted with Tangier's history so that we can grow our membership and remind our city leaders, and those around us, of the significant place Tangier occupies within the community.*

*Someone once said, "You can't know where you are going if you don't know where you've been." Our history is there for us and should serve as a guide and touchpoint as we navigate the many challenges, as well as possibilities, that lay ahead for Tangier.*

*If we use our resources wisely, make sound decisions and remind the community we serve of who we are and why we exist, we will continue to thrive for the next 10 years.....20 years.....50 years.*

## **Peeking at the Past**

### **1890**

Tangier's journey began when it became the 48th chartered Shrine Temple in 1890. Tangier was a young organization establishing its place within the city of Omaha, itself, not yet forty years old. The earliest days of Tangier Temple found Gustav Anderson; Tangier's first potentate from 1889-1891, and a small handful of others, laying the foundation for what would become Tangier Temple and the legacy we continue to enjoy today.

### **1892**

The first time a parade was held at Imperial Session was in Omaha, Nebraska in 1892. The Chief of Police headed the parade with a squad of policemen. There were 1,600 Shriners that participated in the parade including, drum corps, infantry bands, camels and prancing Arabian steeds. The highlight of the event was a mechanical elephant constructed by Moslem Shriners that trumpeted "Shriners Welcome" when his trunk was pulled. (source: Imperial Session - imperialsession.com)

### **1901**

Wednesday January 2, 1901 – Obsequies of the Knights of Kadosh were performed in honor of Past Potentate James "Jim" Gilbert (1845-1901). Illustrious Sir James Gilbert had been the first to conduct these rites and the only one in Nebraska to have conducted the ritual until the time of his death. Gilbert had performed this rite only one month previously for brother William Hay. (source: Omaha World-Herald)

If you have Tangier Shrine, Unit or Club specific clothing or other items that are no longer being used, please consider bringing them back to the shrine. As we know, only a Mason or Shriner can wear/display our iconography and we would like to ensure items remain with their owner or within masonic families, rather than in the public's hands. We can ensure that the items are given back to the unit or club or otherwise handled appropriately. Likewise, if you have "Tangier" branded or "Past Potentate" branded items you would like to donate back to the shrine, we will ensure the items are preserved in our archive. You may leave the items at the office directed to me.

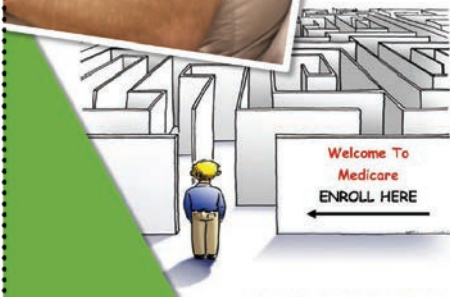
