As most have either read or have heard Tangier is going to reopen on June 22, 2020. With the recommendations from the State of Nebraska and Douglas County Health Department starting to be relaxed we can reopen our building and start to get back to some of the normal functions and events.



Our clubs and units will be able to have meetings. We will be able to run some of our fundraisers. Remember that to accomplish these things the requirement for social distancing will be required. The lounge will be open but there will be some changes that all of us must follow. The Lounge hours of operation will be 12 noon until 10:00 PM Monday through Saturday. Closed on Sunday. Social distancing will be enforced within the guidelines that have been established by the State and County Health Departments. Our rooms will be organized with these guidelines in effect. The moving of tables and chairs currently is not permitted along with no seating at the bar. The lounge for the time being will not be serving food.

Numerous individuals have asked about parades. Currently we do not have any parades scheduled. Most have been canceled with some still undecided.

We received word recently that Central States Shrine Association Ceremonial Session in Springfield MO. has also been canceled.

In times of uncertainty, our strong fraternal bonds lift and support us in ways we could not have imagined. During this unprecedented worldwide health crisis, we are concerned about the health of our families, our fraternal family, our communities, our Shriners Hospitals patients, families and staff, and of course, ourselves.
