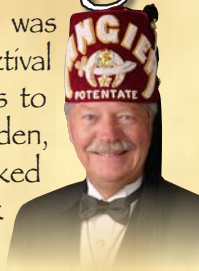

The Onion recipe this month is Sweet Burnt Onions. Charring brings out a level of flavor beyond just caramelizing and goes well with the rich beer glaze. Can be done on a grill, but best if done in a skillet on the grill or stovetop. Instructions

- 1 sweet or yellow onion
- 2 tablespoons light brown sugar or honey
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 tablespoon unsalted butter (optional)
- 1 Remove the skin and outside coughed layer of the onion, but leave the onion whole.
- 2 Slice into 1/4 inch thick rings.
- 3 Season each side with salt and pepper.
- 4 Sprinkle each side with brown sugar.
- 5 Let test for 10 minutes.
- 6 Heat skillet over high heat. Lightly coat skillet with oil. Fry slices for 1-2 minutes per side until darkened.
- 7 Remove skillet from heat and cover with lid to let onions finish softening.
- 8 For extra rich onions, stir in a tablespoon of butter.

Thank you for reading. Please look forward to future entries as we navigate the history that is Tangier.

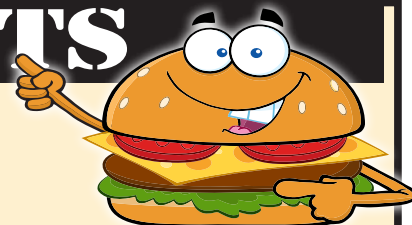
