Tangier Tales

History that is Tangier



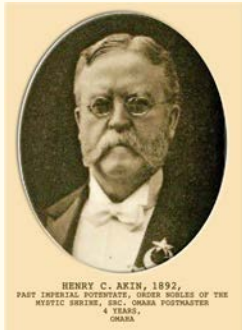
Greetings,

What does it mean to be engaged? There are many definitions: pledged to, busy or occupied with, involved in, bound to, etc. What does it mean to you? As I think about it, I remember our obligation "the tie that bonds us to Freemasonry and to each other." While that should not be a foreign concept to us, it doesn't quite explain or ensure any level of engagement. Becoming fully engaged is a journey, not unlike the path we have all taken on our Masonic journey.

Becoming engaged is a choice we must all make. I believe that to become fully engaged one must first develop a Connection with an organization, group or individual. From there one develops a Commitment to that organization, group or individual. Finally, one becomes actively Engaged in the endeavors and pursuits of that organization, group or individual.

If asked, I'm sure we could all provide examples of those we would identify as "highly engaged" within the Tangier Temple. I have a short list of those individuals, myself. While there are many current examples and many examples we can find among those nobles of the past, are we each Connected, Committed and Engaged? That is a question we must each ask of ourselves.

Peeking at the Past



Henry Akin: Tangier Potentate 1892-1893 & Imperial Potentate June 1902 – July 1903

Henry Clay Akin was born in Spartansburg, PA. August 19, 1843 and passed away December 11, 1935 in Santa Ana, CA. at the age of 92. At the time, Akin was the oldest living Past Potentate of the Shrine. Andrew and Mary Akin, along with son Henry and their other children came west, first settling in Elgin Illinois in 1850 and later having moved to Chicago by 1860. The 1865 census finds the family in Kansas.

Henry was educated in Chicago and served with the Union Army During the Civil War as an Assistant Adjutant General on the staff of General S.M. Wood. After serving his country to preserve the union, Henry rejoined his family in Kansas. Later, Henry can be found in Sioux City Iowa as general manager of the Northwestern Transportation Co. operating a line of steamboats on the Missouri River.

In 1882, Henry arrived in Omaha and was manager of Iler & Co. until 1887. He then became manager of the local offices of the Western Newspaper Union and later Treasurer of the entire system. In 1900, Henry entered the post office holding a variety of positions from finance clerk, cashier, accountant, to treasurer. Henry was a thirty third degree Mason and held a number of positions within many of our

Masonic bodies and has been the only Imperial Potentate from Tangier Shrine, to date. (sources: Omaha World Herald 12 Dec. 1935; Omaha Memories: Recollections of Events, Men & Affairs in Omaha, Neb. From 1879-1917 by Edward Francis Morearty)

Tinley Combs: Tangier Potentate 1919



Tinley Combs was born September 8, 1870 and would find himself an orphan by the age of 7. Both parents having passed away in 1878. Although raised by a guardian; Dr. Emmett Robinson, in many ways, he was dependent upon his own resourcefulness from about the age of 9. Tinley arrived in Omaha in 1889 and began selling jewelry door-to-door. The success he enjoyed allowed him to go into business with three other men, each man using the space for different lines of business. While the other three men failed and left, Tinley persisted. The TL Combs Company was incorporated in 1898 and became one of the finest jewelry establishments in Omaha. Upon his death in 1941, Tinley's sons continued to run the jewelry business until it was sold in 1972. The jewelry business Tinley began in 1889 had been family owned over 80 years.

Tinley's persistence and focus made him a successful businessman, but also served to drive his desire to become a leader in his community. He was raised in the St. John's Lodge No. 25 in 1896 and was later a charter member of Mizpah Lodge No. 302. Tinley was a thirty-third degree Mason and held leadership positions in many of our Masonic bodies, as well as industry associations and civic organizations.

It is undeniable that his crowning achievement was the co-founding, along with eleven other men, of the Omaha Home for Boys. Juvenile Court authorities made a request to local Masonic bodies that a home for orphaned or homeless youth be established. One has but to recall his childhood to understand why he held this project so close to his heart. Tinley was the representative to the board from the Tangier Board of Trustees and was able to secure a \$5,000 Shrine gift for 1920 and a like amount for 1921. While it took the involvement of many people, many ideas and hours of planning, Tinley emerged as a leader among this group. When the corporate name "Nebraska Children's Homefinding Association" caused confusion with other childcare agencies of the time, Tinley was instrumental in gaining approval from the Grand Master of Nebraska Masons to add the word "Masonic" to the name. Thus, the home became the "Masonic Home for Children". His energies and commitment were such that he was continuously voted Board President from the inception of the board in 1920 up to the time of his death in 1941.
