












### Potentate's Message




We are trying a new project this year. We have made up small plastic containers with the Auxiliary logon on them, that we would like you to fill with your change at the end of the day. We learned of this method to increase our coffers when we attended the Annual meeting in Minneapolis in April. The auxiliary that used this method collected a great deal of money, and it doesn't cost us a great deal of money to make it work. One person has used it as a "curse" jar and has already made money. Of course that person adds a dollar each time. We have placed a couple of jars in the lounge and ask if each of you will just dig into your pocket and leave the change. This is not a one-time push. We ask that as you fill it, you take to the Shrine and leave that change and then take it home and fill it again and again. We have a bank that is willing to count all the change. THANK YOU.

We want you to remember that you could give honorariums, memorials or just plain other gifts to the wheelchair fund. So remember that we are doing a good deed for those patients that truly don't have the funds necessary to buy the equipment that will allow them to live an easier life.

One last thing, don't forget to save your aluminum tabs. They do add up and we thank all of you that support us in this project.

Here is a recipe for pickled onions some my find interesting.

2 medium red onion halved and thinly sliced

2 cinnamon sticks

6 whole cloves

Pinch crushed red pepper flakes

1 cup (240 ml) apple cider vinegar

1/2 cup (120 ml) freshly squeezed lime juice 3 tablespoons to 8 tablespoons (38 to 100 grams) sugar, see notes

1 tablespoon kosher salt

### **DIRECTIONS**

Add sliced onions to a medium bowl. Pour enough boiling water over onions so that they are covered. Count to 5 then drain. Add the onions to glass jars (or a food safe glass container with lid).

Toast cinnamon, cloves, and the red pepper flakes until fragrant in a small saucepan over medium heat, 3 to 5 minutes. Whisk in the vinegar, lime juice, 3 tablespoons of the sugar, and salt.


Bring to a simmer and cook until the sugar and salt have dissolved, 1 to 2 minutes. Taste for sweetness then add more sugar as needed.


