As concerns about COVID-19 rise, many are left wondering what can be done. COVID-19 can spread between people through their respiratory secretions, especially when they cough or sneeze. According to the Centers for Disease and Control and Prevention (CDC), the spread of



COVID-19 from person-to-person most likely occurs among close contacts who are within 6 feet of each other.

In keeping with the State of Emergency that has been declared both federally and in the State of Nebraska and keeping with our Grand Master of Nebraska Edict #2; Tangier Shrine Center and all activities, including but not limited to all Regular and Special Communications, fund raising, and social events are canceled until at least June J. 2020. As some of the recommendations least June T, 2020. As some of the recommendations of State and Federal authorities change, the Board of Directors (Divan) will be evaluating these changes. The most recent changes from the State of Nebraska, City of Omaha, and the Douglas County Health Department will not allow for Tangier to reopen. These changes will go into effect on May 4, 2020.

In times of uncertainty, our strong fraternal bonds lift and support us in ways we could not have imagined. During this unprecedented worldwide health crisis, we are concerned about the health of our famílies, our fraternal famíly, our communities, our Shriners Hospitals patients, families and staff, and of course, ourselves. Your leaders of Tangier Shrine are deeply concerned about each of you as well.

We are aware of the many sacrifices and changes you have made to safeguard our fraternity members, families, and your communities by canceling meetings, events and fundraisers. I know that many of you have been forced to discontinue your valuable volunteer work providing patient transportation and other services at our hospitals. In our recent history, this seems unheard of, but we share the legacy of our founders in responding to the needs of our communities, especially those needs of the children of our countries.

We will continue to have some minor fundraising events that do not require a large amount of people to facilitate. Our Grand Master has approved these events if we follow the guidance of Federal and Local officials. Watch for email blasts announcing these

events and support Tangier. Be safe, take care of your health, our families, our fraternal family, our communities and follow the advice of our Federal and State authorities during these difficult times. Hopefully, we will get thought this soon and life as we knew it can get back to normal.




