\$300 level sponsor: What it includes...

1. 3 raffle tickets towards winning the Scheels gift cards.
2. The business/individual/Unit/Club will be put on our "Sponsor placemats."
3. The business/individual/Unit/Club will be put on the Tangier Website in the Sportsman's Raffle section.
4. The business/individual/Unit/Club will be put on smaller various signage around Tangier the day of the event.

\$1,000 level sponsor: What it includes...

1. 15 raffle tickets towards winning the Scheels gift cards.
2. A special banner will be made with the business/individual/Unit/Club name and logo on it and hung in the main room the day of the event.
3. Businesses will be able to put out cards/flyers/etc. at a special "Business sponsors table."
4. Special recognition via the MC on the microphone several times throughout the event.
5. The business/individual/Unit/Club will be put on our "Sponsor placemats."
6. The business/individual/Unit/Club will be put on the Tangier Website in the Sportsman's Raffle section.
7. The business/individual/Unit/Club will be put on smaller various signage around Tangier the day of the event.

Tangier Shrine Unit and Club incentives for selling tickets and/or sponsoring:

1. Any Unit or Club that buys a \$1,000 sponsorship package will be able to have a table the day of the event. At that table, they will be able to do their own custom side raffle (proceeds cannot exceed \$5,000) in which the proceeds **go back to that Unit or Club**. So, if you make enough sales the day of the event in your "custom side raffle," the sponsorship could pay for itself!
2. If any Unit or Club sells 50 tickets COMBINED (meaning checkout tickets under your Unit or Club's name and, if sold, credit will be giving to that group), your Unit or Club will get to have a table at the event to do their own custom raffle, as mentioned above. This can be a very do-able task if you get your members to sell! Ten members sell five each and you're there. And be sure to start your custom Unit/Club raffle before the event so you sell more tickets, as you will have to draw for the prize during the Sportsman's raffle event on April 29<sup>th</sup>.
