Del was also a member of Scottish Rite and the Botna Valley Shrine Club. Del was honored with the YMCA Richard Porter Leadership Award, Westfair 31 year Service Recognition Award, Westfair Hall of Fame, and Rotarian of the Year 2013-2014. The Chanters sang at his funeral service on February 15, 2017.


